

***As Christians, we look to Christ for direction regarding the way we work and play. There are some specific things we can do to make Youth Ministry events safe and enjoyable for everyone. The following are chaperone and driver guidelines for Youth Ministry events.***

***To be a driver for a Youth Ministry trip, the driver must:***

- Be at least 25 years of age
- Possess a valid, non-probationary license and carry the license while doing the actual driving
- Have a valid registration for the vehicle being used
- Have a driver information sheet on file in the Faith Formation Office to include insurance information and a copy of the driver's license
- Have one seat belt per individual

***To participate in an event during the day a chaperone must:***

- Have a signed Blessed Sacrament Volunteer Agreement
- Meet the driver requirements of Blessed Sacrament Youth Ministry
- Have the ability to chaperone youth
- Meet with the coordinator of the event for further direction and/or associate director of youth ministry prior to the event

***To participate in an over night event a chaperone must:***

- Have a signed Blessed Sacrament Volunteer Agreement
- Have diocesan background check
- Have participated in the Virtus "Protecting God's Children Program
- Meet the driver requirements of Blessed Sacrament Youth Ministry
- Have the ability to chaperone youth
- Meet with the coordinator of the event and/or associate director of youth ministry prior to the event
