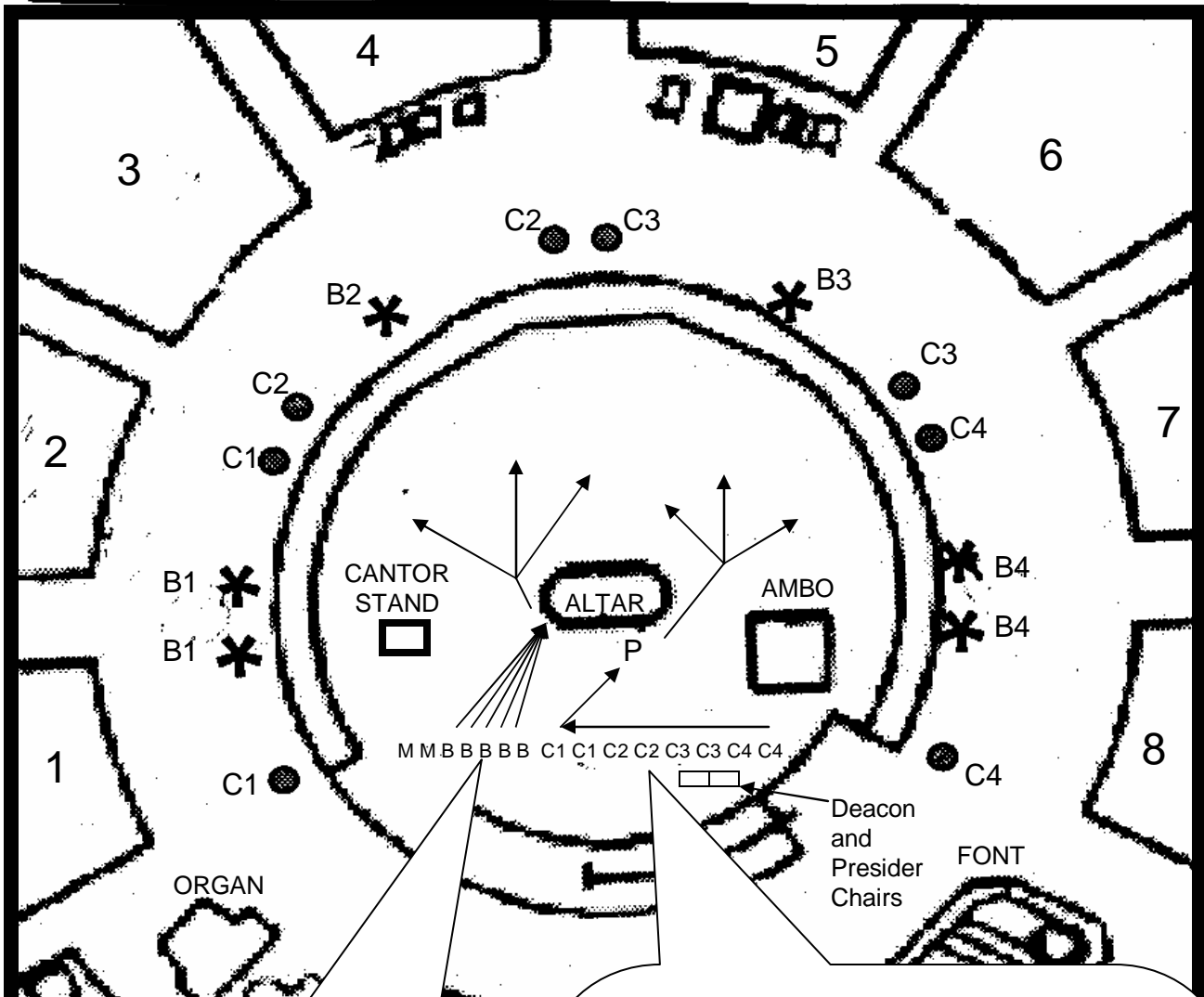


# Detailed Diagram for Eucharistic Minister Positioning and Movement

(Updated 12 February 2008)



## MINISTERS OF CHRIST'S BODY:

- Your station assignment is noted on the sign-in sheet in the Work Sacristy. Check before mass begins.
- After you receive the Blood of Christ from the sacristan or deacon, pick up your bread plate and move to your ASSIGNED station.
- Get to your station using a path on the LEFT side of the altar (see arrows in the above diagram).
- Wait at your station, facing the altar, until your Ministers of Christ's Blood join you.

## MINISTERS OF CHRIST'S BLOOD:

- Your station assignment is determined by how you line up. The first TWO ministers who line up next to the bread ministers are assigned to Station #1, the next TWO to Station #2, etc (denoted by C1 to C4 in the diagram).
- After the presider completes distributing the Body of Christ, he will position himself at the altar (denoted by the P in the diagram).
- The first Minister of Christ's Blood (denoted by C1 in the diagram) approaches the presider and the other Ministers of Christ's Blood follow in line.
- Take your cup and purificator from the presider, drink and move to your ASSIGNED station.
- Get to your station using a path on the RIGHT side of the altar (see arrows in above diagram).
- Wait at your station, facing the altar, until your Minister of Christ's Body joins you.

P = Presider
