

DO'S AND DON'TS FOR SACRISTANS

Blessed Sacrament Church – Midland, Michigan

Do ...

Get a Substitute (if Needed) and Inform Loretta Schepperly of the Change

Show Up at Least 30 Minutes Before the Start of Liturgy
(40 Minutes on Baptism Weekends)

Check “Today’s Liturgy” Notes for Special Requirements

Ensure the Sound System is Turned On (Both Wall and Console Switches)

Turn on the Ambry Light (Two Taps)

Talk with the Presider about Modifying the Amount of Bread and Wine
(Based on the Size of the Assembly and Reserved Christ’s Body in the Tabernacle)

Dispose of Any Soggy or Under-Baked Bread

Stay in the Sacristy Until the Mass Begins

Assist During Baptisms by Standing Near the Font, Instructing the Family Where to
Stand and Where to Go, If Necessary

Use the Table Crumber to Remove Any Crumbs from the Altar after Mass

Carry Liturgical Vessels with Reverence (Both Hands)

Don’t ...

Forget to Remove the Tabernacle Key (after 5 pm and 11 am Mass)

Carry Anything Else When Carrying the Precious Body and Blood of Christ
