Application Information

Pre-admission Requirements

1. **BEFORE** entering school, proof must be provided of a student's appropriate immunizations, tests, or present appropriate waiver forms as set forth by state law. Immunizations are available from the Midland County Health Department at little or no cost. Please contact the **Health Department** with any questions or concerns regarding immunizations at **832-6655**.
2. Copy of birth certificate.
3. Results from preschool vision and hearing testing.
4. A child must be 5 years old by September 1, 2019 to enter Kindergarten.

Admission Policies

1. The child seeking admission must be of legal age and have needs that can be met within the school's educational program.
2. If a parent has any concerns regarding potential educational difficulties for their child, the parent must speak with the principal to discuss available options for special services at Blessed Sacrament.

Application Priority

1. Current Blessed Sacrament (K-5) School families, registered by **February 3, 2019** will be guaranteed their space.
2. Blessed Sacrament Preschool families
3. Former Blessed Sacrament School families
4. Registered Blessed Sacrament Parish families in order of years in the Parish
5. Non-Parish Catholic families who wish a Catholic education for their children.
6. Non-Catholic families who agree to the religious formation of their children according to Catholic principles and philosophy of education.

Applications

1. An application fee of \$100.00 per child will be charged for each application. If this fee presents a hardship, please contact Patrick Bevier at 835-6777 ext 225.
2. Refunds will be given only to families who are not enrolled, due to lack of openings.
