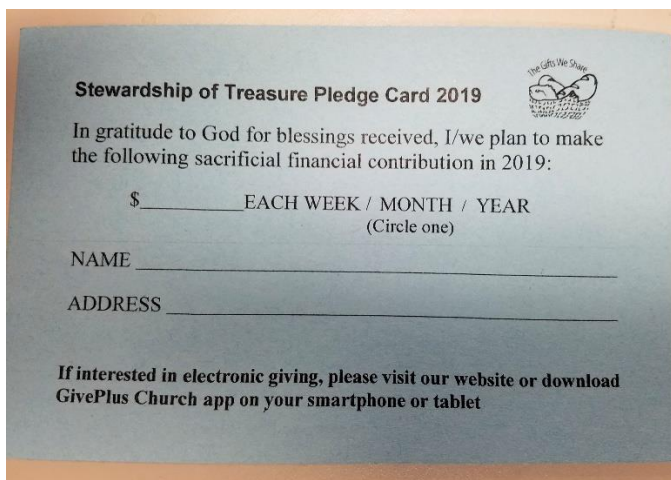

IMPORTANT SNOW DAY MAKE-UPS

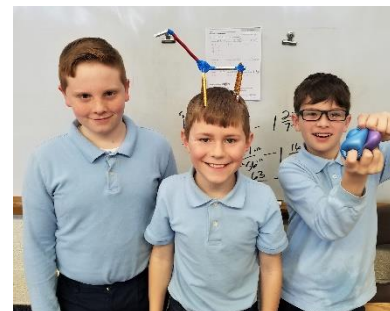
We will make up our **4 snow days on April 22, June 10, 11, and 12th.**
