Ice cream sandwiches will be given to students after concert!

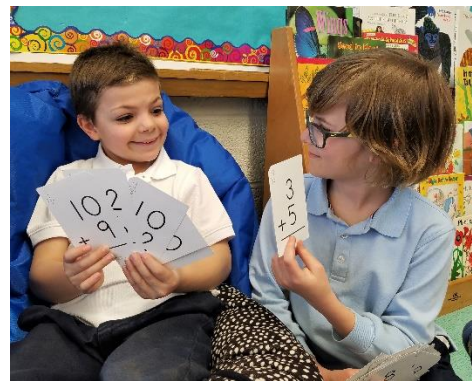

Principal for the Day!

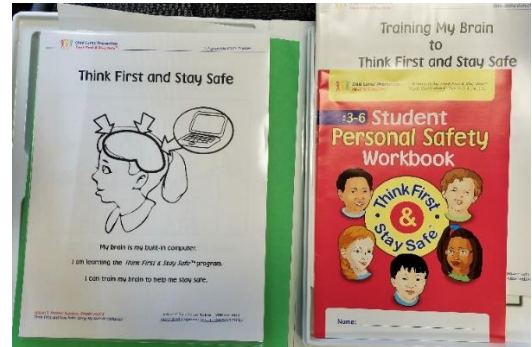
