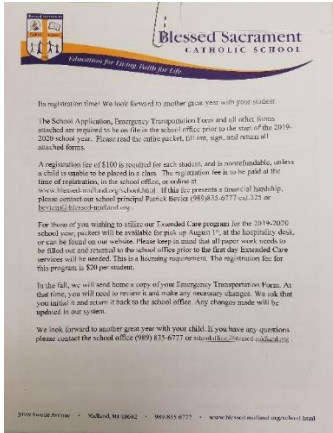

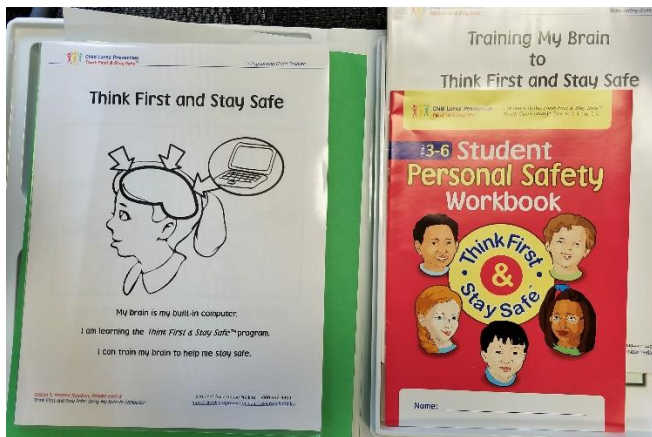


Molly and Vincenzo pose in front of their roller coaster tower based on Newton’s 3 Laws of Motion!

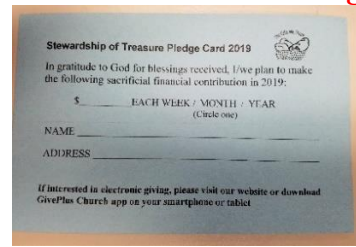
These lessons **teach children to make good decisions with regard to being lured by an older person and other safe decisions.** Please let me know if you have any questions or if you would like to view the materials.
