



### Year End Review

#### **Revenue & Expense Summary**

For the 2020-21 fiscal year our **Revenue** was \$1,968,713 a decrease of 3% over the prior fiscal year revenue. Revenue decreased due to the COVID19 pandemic and our inability to gather resulting in lower Weekend Collections. Despite lower Revenues our **Net Revenue** / Cash Flows increased ~\$356k. because of our lower expenses. **Expenses** were \$1,994,662 down 19% compared to the prior fiscal year. Expenses include employee salaries and benefits, programming related costs, support for Parish ministries, outreach organizations and emergency assistance payments and general maintenance costs.
