

Year End Review

Revenue & Expense Summary

For the 2021-22 fiscal year our **Revenue** was \$1,661,366 a decrease of 18% over the prior fiscal year revenue. Revenue decreased largely due to PPP loan proceeds of \$245,650 received in 2021. Loan was related to COVID19 pandemic relief program by the federal government. Our **Expenses** were \$1,634,442, flat compared to the prior fiscal year. Expenses include employee salaries and benefits, faith formation programming related costs, support for Parish ministries, outreach organizations and emergency assistance payments and general maintenance costs. Our **Net Revenue** / Cash Flows increased by ~\$27k.
