Holy Chrism is a mixture of olive oil and perfume, has been consecrated by our Bishop and the Priest of our Diocese. It will be used to anoint infants after Baptism and those who are confirmed.

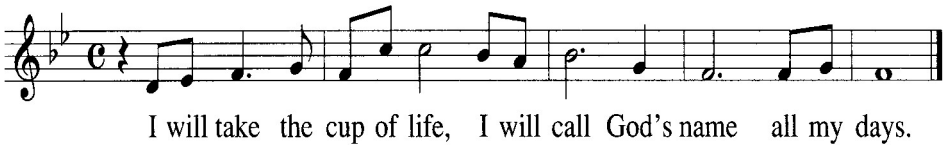





Memorial Acclamation




